Essential Job Functions

- The race director is fully responsible for the staging of the competition
- Coordinate and Lead race leadership team, team captain meetings, participate in ROC meetings, work closely with FIL Sport Coordinator, liaise with Technical Delegates, Jury and medical personnel
- Ability to recognize key skills and abilities in Luge officials and delegate roles and tasks accordingly with the Start Leader and Finish Leader thus creating a strong leadership team
- Liaise with ROC, CLA, FIL and Media.

Requirements

- Possess an International Judges Certification (FIL Level Official) and current on rule changes
- Available and committed to be Race Director for the 2021 World Championships in Whistler
- Excellent communication skills: verbal, written, conflict resolution, positive feedback.
- Has experience as Race Director or Assistant Race Director at Luge Senior or Junior World Cup Races
- Several years' experience volunteering in all leadership positions and race positions as an Official for Luge World Cup races
- Very good understanding of the rules of the sport, their application and interpretation
- Willing to work outside for extended periods of time in adverse weather conditions
- Demonstrated leadership capabilities
- Ability to work under stressful situations and retain composure
- Extensive knowledge of all officiating equipment usage and requirements
- Ability to assume any officials position at the race
- Ability to make decisions under pressure of time
- Ability to delegate to race leadership positions and have those positions be fully responsible for their areas including decision making ability (start, finish, technical, chief of timing)
- Role model of code of conduct
- Very good understanding of all race positions and ability to teach those positions to any new officials
- Work collaboratively with the Race Office, Chief of Track and Track operating organization
- Ensure the safety of all athletes participating in training and the race
- Problem solving capability
- Positive – Can Do Attitude

Expectations

- Required for all training and competition days of the World Cup Luge Event
- Officiated at World Cup during the season prior to the World Cup Luge Event
- Maintain all race documentation in a organized manner
- Ability to focus on race activities
- Ability to address incidents and IRO infractions in a discreet manner
- Ability to recognize and intervene appropriately before a potential situation develop
